These purchases are necessary due to the realignment of Indiana University Purdue University Fort Wayne, which redefined Indiana University’s academic mission to focus on health sciences programs. The realignment agreement was approved by the Board of Trustees on December 1, 2016. The Program Transfer Agreement and ancillary agreements necessary to effectuate the IPFW Realignment were approved by the Board of Trustees on June 16, 2017.
